

Parent Community Needs Survey - Summary Report

In October 2021, we conducted a survey and asked parents to answer a number of questions in order to assess how we can best support our school community.

All parents received an invitation to participate in this online survey. Participation was voluntary and respondents were ensured confidentiality.

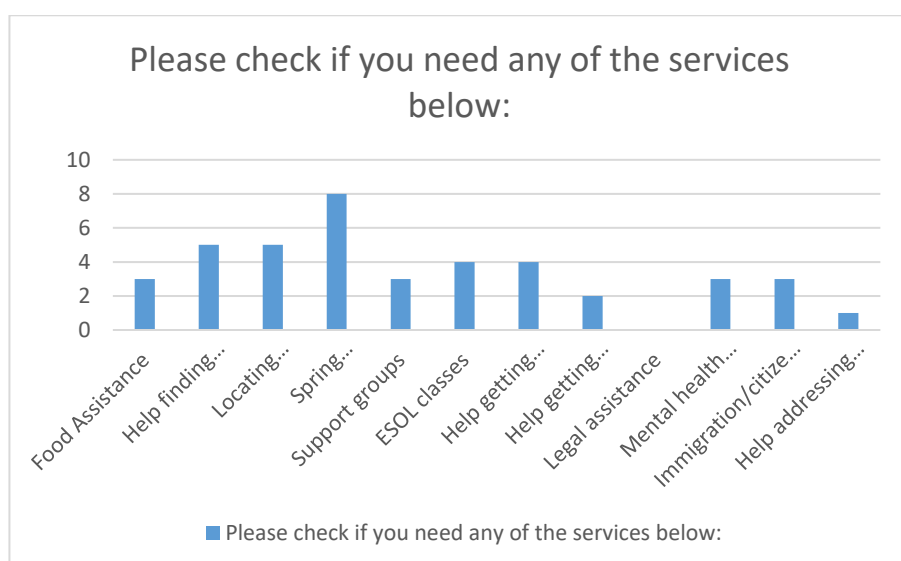
Asked about what they like most about our school community, the main responses included our friendly, experienced, caring and welcoming staff and school environment, the cultural diversity and good communication.

The next question was about what are your/your family's greatest needs and the overwhelming answer was education. Other factors mentioned were the children's emotional wellbeing, socialising and developing good relationships with their peers, extracurricular and sport activities, as well as a cultural awareness of all religions.

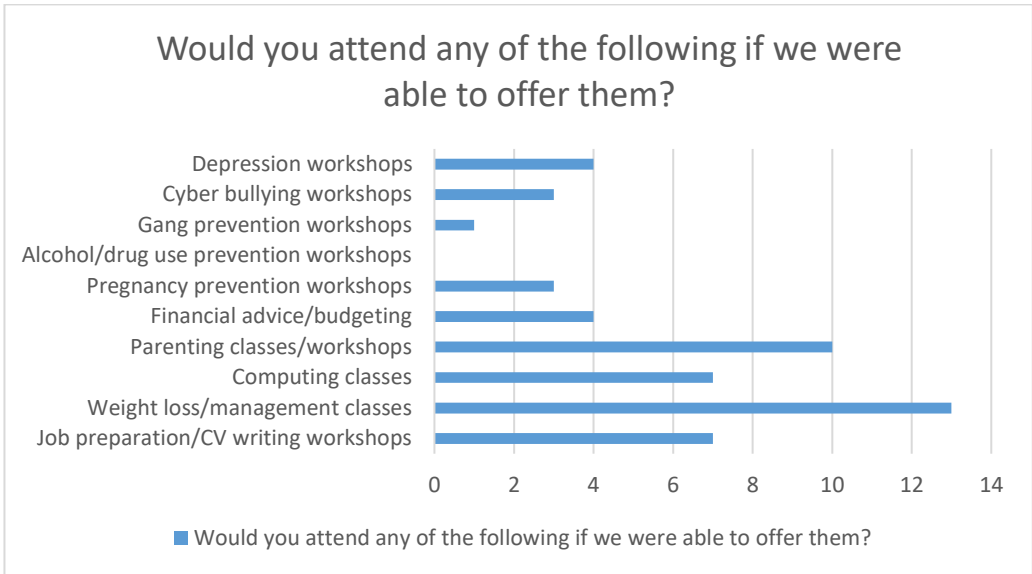
When asked about what they thought other pupils, parents and families might struggle with, several respondents commented that other families struggle with socialising and language barriers.

We also asked for recommendations of any organisations that we could reach out to help support our school community. While most did not have any recommendations, a few answers referred to Newcastle Central Mosques and Newcastle libraries.

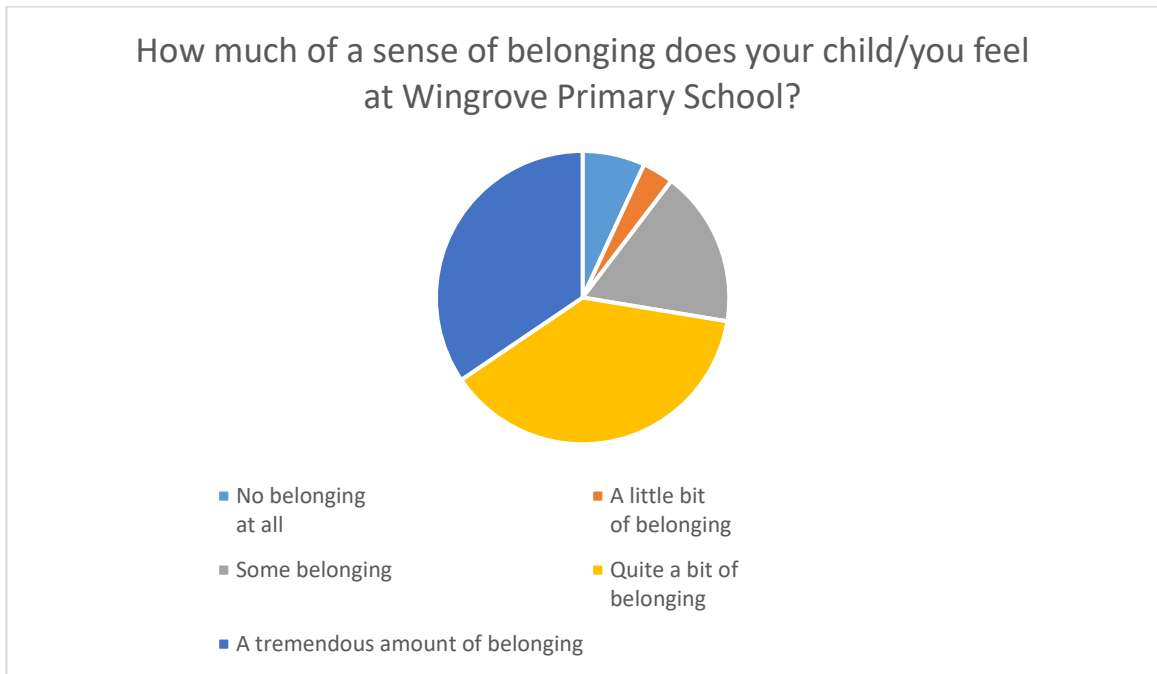
When asked about services, the chart below shows that most families would like information or access to spring/summer camps, with others needing help accessing different services.



If they were to be offered workshops or classes, the majority of parents asked for a weight loss/management class, followed by parenting, job preparation and computing classes with a few mentioning depression, budgeting, cyber-bullying and pregnancy prevention workshops.



Overall, most parents think their children feel a tremendous sense of belonging at Wingrove Primary School with very few saying they only feel a bit or no belonging at all.



To follow up on the parents’ requests for workshops, signposting to different services and clubs, we will look at continually updating the school website with relevant information and will start a number of parents’ workshops from January 2022.
